


Installation Guide

Dual Power Supply Holster with Power Strip for 2"/5.1cm diameter post

Purpose

1. To describe the installation of the Dual Power Supply Holster to a 2" Roll Stand Post.




Parts Reference

The following parts and hardware are included with this installation kit (hardware not shown)

1	Dual Power Supply Holster including Power Strip with 12" Velcro Straps, attached to a 2" RS Block with inserts	1
2	Cord Wrap attached to a 2" RS Block w/ Bores	1
3	10-32 X 9/16" PHMS	2
4	5/16 Nylon HD Cable Clamp	2
5	8-32 x 1/4" PHMS	2
6	#8 Flat Washer (.03 THK X .375 OD)	2
7	18" Hook and loop straps	4


Tools Required: (Not Provided)

Installing Power Strip Holster and Cord Wrap to Roll Stand Post

Min. Power Supply Size Using 12" [30.5 cm] Hook & Loop Straps	Max. Power Supply Size Using 18" [45.7cm] Hook & Loop Straps
1.4" [3.56 cm] x 2.3" [5.84 cm] or 7.4" [18.8 cm] perimeter	4.0" [10.16 cm] x 4.0" [10.16 cm] or 16" [40.6 cm] perimeter



Routine Maintenance

Periodically inspect all fasteners associated with the mounting assembly. Tighten or adjust as necessary for optimal operation and safety.

Cleaning the Mounting Assembly

- 1. The mounting assembly may be cleaned with most mild, non-abrasive solutions commonly used in the hospital environment (e.g. diluted bleach, ammonia, or alcohol solutions).
- 2. The surface finish will be permanently damaged by strong chemicals and solvents such as acetone or trichloroethylene.
- 3. Steel wool or other abrasive material should never be used.
- 4. Damage caused by the use of unapproved substances or processes will not be warranted. We recommend testing of any cleaning solution on a small area of the mounting assembly that is not visible to verify compatibility.
- 5. Never submerge or allow liquids to enter the mounting assembly. Wipe any cleaning agents off the arm immediately using a water-dampened cloth. Dry the mounting assembly thoroughly after cleaning.
